

Strategic Plan – IHHS Clinical Services Division

One Year Plan

1) *Maintain the identity and presence of the IHHS Clinical Services Division (in light of the scheduled renovations)*

Action Goals:

- a) Continue to hold regular (monthly) advisory board meetings
- b) Provide continued communication about evolving initiatives and services within and outside the university community (e.g., Methamphetamine project, mental health in the schools)
- c) Maintain and improve website content and begin working on a brochure
- d) Develop a 5 year strategic plan for the Division
- e) Develop an appropriate name for the clinical service operation

2) *Prepare to provide on-site services*

Action Goals:

- a) Manage the scheduled renovations
- b) Communicate regularly (via liaison) between planned service units and the construction team (i.e., ASU personnel, contractors, architects) to ensure that the construction addresses the clinical needs of the IHHS, meets established discipline requirements, and HIPAA guidelines
- c) Complete advisory subcommittee work

3) *Foster the vision of interdisciplinary collaboration within the University and in the community*

Action Goals:

- a) Ensure that the staff from each service unit (discipline) educates the others as to the nature, scope, and practice parameters of their unit
- b) Create opportunities for various community constituents to provide information about what is currently available and what is needed in terms of service provision
- c) Continue to develop the strategic plan for the IHHS
- d) Develop promotional materials

3 Year Plan

- 1) *Develop and provide services within the community and take services to the various constituents (home, school-based)*

Action Goals:

- a) Identify needed services and gaps in service delivery (e.g., non-competitive, access, transportation limitations)
- b) Build relationships with professional and community partners
- c) Implement services in priority areas (e.g., methamphetamine, autism spectrum disorders, school-based mental health initiatives)

- 2) *Develop and implement clinical training and educational opportunities for students*

Action Goals:

- a) Supervise and facilitate the interaction of students in the interdisciplinary learning community
- b) Provide opportunities for funded research and clinical activities

- 3) *Develop and implement clinical seminars for community and regional professionals*

Action Goals:

- a) Co-sponsor workshops with AHEC and other professional agencies
- b) Provide trainings and seminars for the purpose of maintaining professional credentialing (e.g., CEUs)

- 4) *Encourage and explore innovative approaches to meeting human service needs*

Action Goals:

- a) Foster an interdisciplinary culture that is both respectful of evidence-based practice and open to innovative approaches
- b) Collaborate with the research division to examine clinical practice

5 Year Plan

- 1) *Facilitate an established network of community based services*
- 2) *Implement and evaluate innovative approaches to meeting human service needs and disseminate information to the appropriate audiences*
